FLYING MEMBERSHIP SUBSCRIPTION	
Joining Fee	\$75 once only (waived for members of other gliding clubs and for Junior members)
Full Flying Membership	\$460 per annum payable in two tranches + GNZ + Magazine
Additional Family Member	\$95 per annum + GNZ + Magazine
Junior Member	\$Nil per annum
Non-Flying Membership	\$40 per annum
National gliding magazine (“Magazine”)	\$75 per annum – Free to Junior members
Gliding NZ affiliation fee (“GNZ”)	\$100 per annum – No levy for Junior members
Gliding NZ affiliation fee for visiting pilots from overseas (“GNZ”)	\$25 for one week, or \$60 for more than one week up to three months

For an upfront payment of \$400 – all glider hire is at the low rate of 30c per minute (\$18 per hour). Summer season runs from 1 December to 31 May.

Prepaid to Solo Flying Training

Introduction

This plan has been put in place as an optional form of membership to the Wellington Gliding Club to provide potential members with a fixed price for flight training to solo standard. The plan does not guarantee a member his/her first solo flight within the six month time frame and 40 flights, but experience shows us that students of average ability should attain the standard required for a safe and satisfying first solo flight in one of our two-seater aircraft. All flying done after the first solo flight is charged at normal club rates.

The cost of the plan is \$3,700

Payment method is by two payments of \$1,850 each. The first payment is due at the time of the first flight, and the second once 12 flights have been completed. Refunds or unused pre-payments are not payable or transferable. The plan includes:

Plan members will enjoy full membership of the Wellington Gliding Club and its facilities and likewise be bound by its rules. Plan membership does not imply or involve any special rights or priorities over other Club members. If Plan members wish to remain a member of the Club after expiry of their six months membership they will be required to pay the balance of the annual sub to the end of the financial year.

Membership Definitions

Flying Member – Being a person over the age of eighteen years at the date of joining or over eighteen years on 31 October in each year thereafter.

Junior Member – Being a person aged eighteen years or under at the time of joining the Club, or on 31 October in each year thereafter.

Family Member – Being a person residing permanently with a Full Member who is that person’s parent, partner or sibling and where the person is not a Junior or Non-flying Member.

Non-Flying Member – Being a person of any age who is interested in the welfare and activities of the Club. Non-flying Members are entitled to participate in all Club activities except flying.

Short-Term Flying Member – Being a person wishing to experience gliding and possibly consider taking it up as a sport.
